Appendix I: Overview of the data used in Chapter 2

This appendix presents, per sample language, the alienable and inalienable possessive marking strategies and their analysis in terms of locus, following the typology presented in Chapter 2. The 13 languages used to test the hypothesis in (iii) are marked in bold. Commas separate the use of multiple marking strategies and a dash indicates that sufficient data is lacking. For examples and discussion, consider Section 2.2.4. The following abbreviations are used:
