The sentence currently reads: For Cluster-C PD costs in the Netherlands are estimated between 48,000 and 79,000 euros per person per year [10] and consist of elevated health costs, patient and family costs, productivity losses, and costs in other sectors.

The sentence should read: For Cluster-C PD costs in the Netherlands are estimated between 12,000 and 13,500 euros per person per year (in 2007 prices) [10] and consist of elevated health costs, patient and family costs, productivity losses, and costs in other sectors.
