## Curriculum Vitae

Joost Verhoeff was born on 3 June 1976 in Utrecht, The Netherlands. As son of an academic veterinarian his training in medicine started at an early age. During his high school years he was active as a basketball player, referee and coach and played bass guitar in several bands.

After graduation he studied medicine at the University of Antwerpen (RUCA, Belgium, 1995) and psychology at the University of Amsterdam (UvA, 1996). He got his truck driving license and during holidays he transported various cargos through Europe.

In 1998 he finally was allowed by the governmental lottery system to attend a Dutch medical school, the University of Amsterdam (UvA).

From 2001 to 2003, next to his study, he functioned as board member of the AMC medical school (OwiGen) and as member of the board of the Netherlands Association for Medical Education (NVMO). Since 2004 he is member of the board of *the worldwide access to medical advances* foundation, that stimulates transference of medical knowledge to developing countries.

This PhD research project started in 2003 following his scientific internship (prof.dr. D.J. Richel, prof.dr. C.C.E. Koning, supervisors dr. W.R. van Furth and dr. L.J.A. Stalpers).

In 2004 he received his master's degree in Medicine and started his internships in the Amsterdam area. Luckily, his co-promoter dr. Lukas Stalpers urged him to apply for an internship at the department of radiation oncology (prof. dr. C.C.E. Koning). In 2006 he registered as Medical Doctor. For two years he performed full time research to speed up completion of his thesis.

In September 2008 he started the training program in radiation oncology at the Academic Medical Center (prof.dr. C.C.E. Koning). He will finish his radiation oncology training in 2014.
